## We help children to achieve their full potential by:

- Recognising the unique worth of each individual, helping them to understand themselves –strengths, weaknesses, ambitions, fears, abilities and challenges – so they can face every new situation positively
- Developing in children a firm grasp of core educational knowledge, understanding and skills, especially

- Challenging children to value their achievements, to have ambition for achieving more and never to be content with anything less than their best.

## We provide a secure, happy and caring environment by:

- Setting a high standard of behaviour and expectation, modelling this as adults and challenging children to also achieve this, being aware of the needs of each other and strengthening friendships and a sense of community
- o Providing boundaries, routines and consistency in as much of school life as possible

- Responding quickly to needs and incidents, but also pro-actively teaching children how to deal with challenges and issues before they might meet them
- Ensuring that reasonable steps are taken to provide children with quality learning environments, resources and learning experiences
