- · the early learning goals in the prime areas of learning (personal, social and emotional development; physical development; and communication and language) and;
- the early learning goals in the specific areas of mathematics and literacy.

The table below shows the data from 2016 - 2017.

80.9% of pupils at St Martin's attained a good level of development across all key areas.

75.1% of pupils in Hampshire attained a good level of development across all key areas.

69.3% of pupils nationally attained a good level of development across all key areas.
