

St Martin's CE (Aided) Primary School 2017 KS2 SATs Results: Headline figures



At the end of KS2 (Yr6), children take SATs in reading, maths and EGPS (English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling). The outcomes of these tests are reported as a scaled score ranging from 80 to 120, with 100 representing the Expected Standard and 110 or more representing a High Score.

Teachers are also required to assess children against the interim descriptors in reading, writing, maths and science.

68.8% of pupils at St Martin's achieved the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics with 6.3% achieving a high score.

65.2% of pupils in Hampshire achieved the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics with 11.0% achieving a high score.

61.1% of pupils nationally achieved the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics with 8.6% achieving a high score.
