2017 EYFS Results: Headline figures

At the end of EYFS (Year R), teachers are required to assess each child in the 17 areas of learning. Children are assessed as emerging, expecting or exceeding each of the Early Learning Goals.

Children are considered to have achieved a Good Level of Development if they achieve (or exceed) the Early Learning Goal in:

- the prime areas of learning (personal, social and emotional development; physical development; and communication and language),
- the specific areas of mathematics and literacy.

76.2% of pupils at St Martin's achieved a Good Level of Development.

75.7% of pupils in Hampshire achieved a Good Level of Development.

70.7% of pupils nationally achieved a Good Level of Development.
